OUR STAFF

At Bambinos we have amazing and well-qualified staff. Each classroom has a bilingual team of teachers. Our Head Teachers have college education in early childhood and our assistant teachers must have previous experiences working with children. One of the teachers will have Spanish as their first language and the other will have English.

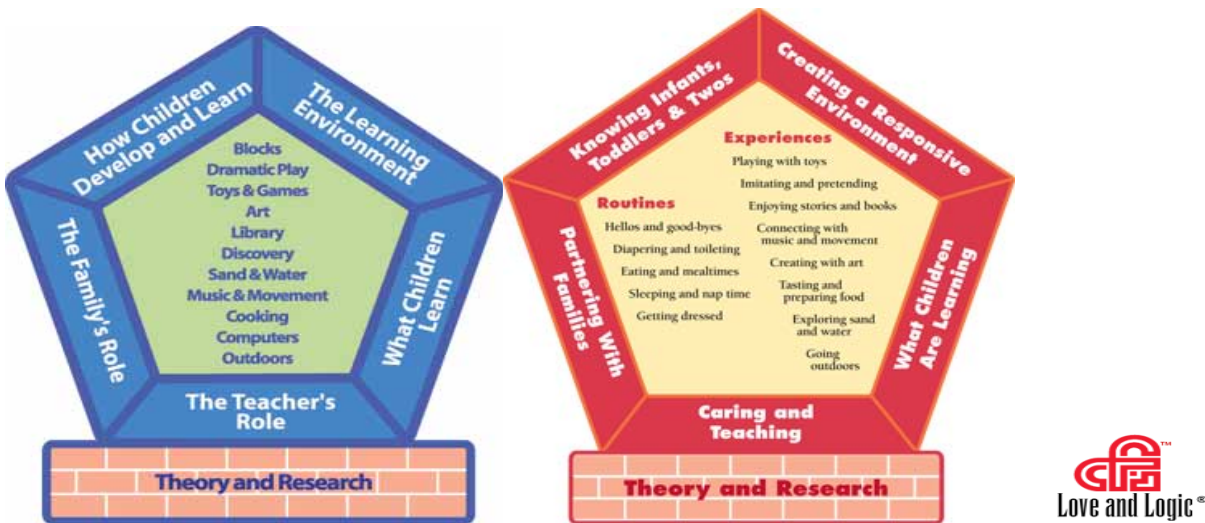

OUR PROGRAMS

As parents ourselves, we understand that choosing an early childhood program that you are comfortable with can be a difficult task. We would like to take a moment to assure you that it is extremely important to us that you and your child are satisfied with our services.

It is also very important that your child feels loved and respected while at our center, and at the same time understands that there are rules established for his/her safety and for the well being of all the children at the center. In addition, children are encouraged to be respectful to their peers in each classroom.

Our programs are based on the "Creative Curriculum." Knowing how children develop and learn is the basis of planning our program, selecting materials, and guiding children's learning. The Creative Curriculum enhances social/emotional, physical, cognitive and language development. The learning environment is the structure of the classroom that sets the context for teaching and learning.



Our discipline method is based on the "Love and Logic" curriculum.

Love and Logic is a philosophy founded by Jim Fay and Foster W. Cline, M.D., and is based on the experience of a combined total of over 75 years working with and raising kids. It provides simple and practical techniques to help teachers and parents have less stress and more fun while raising responsible kids. Love and Logic offers many useful techniques that teachers and parents can begin experimenting with immediately. Here are some examples:

- Locking-in sadness or empathy before delivering consequences
- Setting limits with enforceable statements
- Sharing control through lots of small choices
- Building relationships with the One Sentence Intervention
- Neutralizing arguing with the Brain Dead technique
- The Anticipatory Consequence

Love and Logic is easy to use, raises responsible kids, and changes lives.

INFANTS

Your baby is **UNIQUE**. We do not expect your child to fit into a rigid schedule. Instead, we will follow your baby's individual needs for feeding, sleeping and playful interaction to mirror your patterns at home. A "Personal Plan" helps us meet your infant's unique needs.

Your baby is also ready to learn, so we have daily activities that will stimulate his/her natural curiosity and healthy development.

Infant Foundations

- Low staff – child ratio
- Flexible, personal daily schedules for each infant
- Age-appropriate toys, games, music
- Stimulating activities and group interactions

TODDLERS

Our toddler program introduces your child to a more structured day with stimulating activities, group interaction and the chance to be inquisitive as he/she begins to talk, walk and explore.

Environment

- **Science Area:** Toddlers will discover basic science concepts such a weight, volume, fluidity
- **Block Area:** Toddlers develop fine motor skills and coordination by sorting, grouping and balancing blocks and simple shapes. They also exercise creative thinking and problem solving.
- **Library:** Age appropriate books.
- **Dramatic Play:** By acting out events from their life and pretending, they will explore language and social skills
- **Active Play:** Area indoor soft blocks give toddlers fun ways to practice large muscle control and agility

Pre-School (4's – 5's)

We offer a Bilingual and an Immersion Pre-school Program

Our preschool programs grow along with your child, teaching essential reading, writing, math, science and social skills in a logical, natural sequence that encourages children to learn step by step.

Monthly themes, weekly topics and daily activities keep the curriculum focused and fun. We complement this learning experience by bringing a Music Teacher, Yoga teacher, art teacher and a Sign Language Teacher on a weekly basis.

Our goal is to have a balance between the nurturing care children received as infants and toddlers and the growing structure and independence that will define their school years.
